Safety and Access

We want everyone to have a safe and enjoyable visit. Covid is still a risk: please do not visit if you feel unwell or have tested positive.

- Drivers should proceed past the Tower and park in the visitor car park, avoiding grass areas.
- Pedestrian entrance is via the road bordered with white concrete hoops leading to the Moller Building, café and shop.
- Please give others space in confined areas. Try to follow the arrows in narrow walkways. If we are busy, you may be asked to wait or see another part first.
- Face masks are available for those who wish to wear them.
- The café and shop are open. Refreshments may be consumed inside or out.
- Please use hand sanitisers before touching displays or sale items.
- We encourage fresh air. There is an air purifier in the cinema. Light cleaning of surfaces is done at intervals during the day.
- Restrooms are checked regularly and cleaned if necessary.
- First Aid supplies are in the café and tower ground floor.
- If an alarm sounds, leave by the nearest exit and assemble on grass area by car park.
- Please let staff know if you have any additional needs. We have a disabled toilet and baby changing. A wheelchair is available. Access to upper floors in the Tower may be difficult for some but there is a handrail each side of the staircase.
